





Pregnancy Testing

Free confidential pregnancy tests are offered to women in Oswego County. Women from the high school, college, and surrounding community use this local resource. We offer practical resources and caring guidance in a safe setting for anyone experiencing an unplanned pregnancy or seeking assistance relating to a pregnancy or past abortion. Our trained advocates listen to concerns, and questions and discuss all options in a caring and non-judgmental manner. We offer referrals to adoption agencies and community resources.



Parenting Classes

“Earn While You Learn” is a parenting class system used to provide new parents with helpful information as well as necessary baby items such as clothes and food. Parents are asked to come in, watch parenting DVD’s, participate in discussion, and complete take-home activities. The classes are both one-on-one and in a group setting. In exchange for their time, the PCC will offer “Mentor Money” which can be used in the boutique at the Center to purchase diapers, clothes and much more.

#Realtalk

Realtalk is an abstinence-based presentation for junior high school students that explores the risks of premarital sex and educates students about the emotional, mental, physical, sexual, and spiritual components of their lives that are affected through sexual contact.

Realtalk is offered free of charge as an in-class presentation. Carmella Smith and Ben Titus lead the class in various interactive demonstrations that teach STD and pregnancy awareness through the use of accurate, statistical information and personal testimonies.

For the past 35 years, the PCC has responded to those with unintended pregnancies that need resources and someone to listen. The PCC continues to thrive with 5 part-time employees, a growing base of volunteers, an Executive Board of Directors and a large community of support from county churches, individual donors and area businesses. This past year the PCC added the Heart 2 Heart program to serve mom's in a group setting and open up the conversation about everything from parenting to relationships and shopping to the Word of God!

The Lord has continued to open doors this year and we have been hugely blessed as we serve Him through serving others and be a lamp on a hill to the community as a whole. Please pray that God will continue to open the hearts of those in our community to partner with us.




- Several Churches also support the Center on a monthly or quarterly basis.

A one-time gift of \$1,500 can pay for **50%** of our Prevention Program.



\$50,522**




**2018 Income:

- 157 of our clients are women and 15 are men.




